Mr. Lamoureux and Mr. Goloskie will address the following issues as they relate across industries and more specifically to health care employers: employee use of social media and how to monitor and regulate social media in the workplace; the intersection of social media and medical privacy, legal issues regarding hiring decisions based on information obtained from social media websites; and the steps employers and medical providers can take to protect themselves.
